ORDER

(Issued under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005)

The appellant submitted two numbers of RTI application dated 29.04.2025, under Section 6 of the Right to Information Act, 2005, (hereafter “the Act”) to the respondent society and sought for certain information as given below:

The Appellant has not received any response from the Respondent society.

2. Aggrieved by the non-response of the respondent society, the appellant filed this first appeal dated 02.06.2025 on the ground that, no reply was received for his Forms dated 29.04.2025.

3. The response of the respondent was called for, vide notice dated 05.06.2025. The respondent has furnished its response vide letter dated 27.06.2025 (received in this office on 30.6.2025- **Copy Enclosed**).

4. On perusal, it is observed that, the 2nd respondent society has now furnished available information to the appellant for his 2 nos. of RTI applications dated 29.04.2025 vide letters dated 27.05.2025 & 29.05.2025. The reply were sent to the appellant vide ‘Registered Post with Acknowledgement due’ which were despatched to the given address of the appellant on 02.06.2025 (**Acknowledgement Copy Enclosed**), ie after this First Appeal is filed on 30.05.2025.

5. In view of the above submissions, it is found that, the plea of the appellant is redressed. As nothing survives in this appeal, this first appeal is dismissed.

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6. It is further noticed that, the 2nd respondent-society failed to furnish his reply within the stipulated time limit of 30 days. If the respondent-society furnished his reply to the appellant within the stipulated time limit of 30 days, this first appeal wouldn't be preferred by the appellant.

7. Hence, the respondent-society is directed to meticulously adhere the provisions of the said Act, in letter and spirit, and henceforth dispose of the applications under the said Act within the stipulated time limit of 30 days; failing which the respondent will be subjected to legal consequences as per the penal provisions of the said Act.

8. If aggrieved by this decision, a 2nd Appeal may be filed, under Section 19(3) of the Act, within 90 days, with the 2nd Appellate Authority, whose address is given below:
