**ORDER**

Sub: Chief Secretariat (Co-operation) – Deputation of Thiru. P. Vadivelmurugan, Co-operative Officer as Managing Director to Pondicherry Co-op. Milk Producers' Union Ltd., (PONLAIT) - Orders – Issued.

Ref: E-Office no.A-35017/3/2025 Dt. 05/05/2025 of the RCS, Co-operative Department, Puducherry.

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Approval of the competent authority is hereby accorded to the deputation of Thiru. P. Vadivelmurugan, Co-operative Officer to Pondicherry Co-op. Milk Producers Union Ltd.,(PONLAIT) as Managing Director and also hold the additional charges as Managing Director, Urban Bank, Puducherry. The following terms and conditions of deputation as mentioned below are communicated for a period of three years or till the date of retirement on superannuation or till the necessity therefore ceases, whichever is earlier.

i) Pay: During the period to Foreign Service/Deputation, the officer will draw pay of the post held by him in his parent department plus Deputation (Duty) Allowance in accordance with and subject to the conditions laid down in O.M. No. 6/8/2009-Estt.(Pay II), dt. 17-06-2010 of the Government of India, Department of Personnel and Training, communicated in I.D. Note No. A.35011/1/2002/DPAR/CCD(2) dated 06-01-2011 and Circular No. A.35013/2/2013/DPAR/SS-I(2), dated 06-06-2013 and I.D. Note/Memorandum No.A.35011/1/2002/DPAR/CCD(2), dt. 23-08-2021, of the Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms, Puducherry as modified from time to time.

ii) Tenure: The Tenure of Deputation will be for a period of three years from the date of joining in the Deputation post or till the necessity therefore ceases, whichever is earlier.

iii) Dearness Allowance and Other Allowance: During the period of Foreign Service, he/she will be entitled to Dearness Allowance under the rules of the parent Department or under the rules of the borrowing Department/Agency/Corporation. Accordingly, as he/she retains his/her scale of pay of parent Department or he/she draw pay in a pay scale attached to the post under the borrowing Department/Agency/Corporation.

iv) Leave: During the period of Foreign Service, he/she will continue to be governed by the leave rules applicable to him/her in his/her parent Department/Agency/Corporation.

v) Compensatory Allowance: The Whole expenditure in respect to compensatory allowance for the period of leave in or at the end of the Foreign Service shall be borne by the borrowing Department/ Agency/ Corporation.

vi) Travelling Allowance: For journey on duty in Foreign Service, the TA rules of the Central Government would apply.

vii) Disability Leave: The borrowing Department/ Agency/ Corporation will be liable to pay the leave salary in respect of special disability leave granted to the above

official on account of any disability incurred through foreign service under the borrowing authority even if such disability manifest itself after the terminal of foreign service.

viii) Leave Travel Concession: During the period of Foreign Service, he/she will be entitled to LTC as admissible under the Central Government Rules, the liability in this regard being borne by the borrowing Department/ Agency/Corporation.

ix) Medical facilities and Educational Concessions: During the period of foreign service, he/she will be entitled to medical facilities and educational concessions not inferior to those he/she would have enjoyed had he/she remain in the service of the Government.

x) Contribution: The leave salary and pension contribution will be paid by the borrowing Department/Agency/Corporation. Contribution for leave salary of pension due in respect of the Government Servant in Foreign Service may be paid annually within fifteen days from the end of each financial year or at the end of the Foreign Service. If the deputation in foreign service expires before the end of financial year and if the payment is not made within the said period interest must be paid to Government on the unpaid contribution, unless it is specifically permitted by the President at the rate of two paise per day for Rs.100/- from the date of expiry of the period aforesaid upto the date on which the contribution is finally paid. The interest shall be paid by the Government Servant or the foreign employer accordingly as the Contribution is paid by the former or the latter. The Leave Salary and Pension contribution should be paid separately, as they are creditable to different head of accounts, no dues, recoverable from the Government Servant on any account should be set of against leave contributions.
