NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with the Notification No.F.5/4/65-GP dated 11th January, 1965 of the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India, New Delhi and in supersession of the earlier notification issued vide G.O.Ms.No.7/Co-op. dated 17th August, 2000 and published as Supplement to the Gazette No.40 dated 3rd October, 2000 save as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Lieutenant-Governor, Puducherry, hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the Group "B" post of Deputy Registrar of Co-operative Societies in the Co-operative Department, Government of Puducherry, namely: -

1. *Short title and commencement.* - (1) These rules may be called the Government of Puducherry, Co-operative Department, Group "B" Gazetted and Non-Ministerial post of Deputy Registrar of Co-operative Societies Recruitment Rules, 2015.

(2). They shall come into force on and from the date of their publication in the official gazette.

2. *Number of post, its classification and Pay Band and Grade Pay / Pay Scale.* - The number of the said post, its classification and the Pay Band and grade Pay / Pay Scale attached thereto, shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed hereto.

3. *Method of recruitment, age-limit and other qualifications.* - The method of recruitment to the said post, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto, shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. *Disqualifications.* - No person, -

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any other person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post;

Provided that the Lieutenant-Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. *Power to relax.* - Where the Lieutenant-Governor, is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. *Saving.* - Nothing in these rules shall affect the reservations, relaxation in upper age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the scheduled castes, the scheduled tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in this regard.

3. Classification	:	General Central Service Group 'B'- Gazetted - Non-Ministerial
4. Level in the Pay Matrix	:	Level 7 of the Pay Matrix
5. Whether selection post or non-selection post	:	Selection
6. Age limit for direct recruits	:	Not Applicable
7. Educational and other qualifications required for direct recruits	:	Not applicable
8. Whether age and educational qualifications prescribed for direct recruits will apply in the case of promotees.	:	Not Applicable
9. Period of probation, if any	:	Two Years (for promotees)
10. Method of recruitment, whether by direct recruitment or by promotion or by deputation / absorption and percentage of the vacancies to be filled by various methods.	:	Promotion

Departmental Test in Co-operation, Auditing, Book-keeping and Banking conducted by the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission; and (ii). Accounts Test for Executive Officers conducted by the Puducherry Administration; and have successfully completed training in anyone of the following Viz., (a). Salient provisions of the Puducherry Co-operative Societies Act and Rules; (b). Labour Laws, Income Tax Act and Allied laws; or (c). Right to Information Act (d) I.T. applications. Note-(1): Holders of a B.Com. (Hons.) or M.Com. Degree with Co-operation as one of the subjects would be deemed to have passed the tests referred to at (i) above. Note-(2): Holders of a B.Com. Degree would be deemed to have passed the Departmental Test in Book-keeping referred to at (i) above

		Note-(3): Where juniors who have completed their qualifying / eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying / eligibility service or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade along with their juniors who have already completed such qualifying / eligibility service. Note-(4): For the purpose of computing minimum qualifying service for promotion, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1.1.2006 / the date from which the revised pay structure based on the Sixth Central Pay Commission recommendations has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding Grade pay / pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the Pay Commission.
