**ORDER**

***(Issued under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005)***

The appellant submitted an application dated 14.12.2021, under Section 6 of the Right to Information Act, 2005, (hereafter “the Act”) to the respondent-society and sought for certain information from the respondent. The respondent furnished the information to the appellant on 13.01.2022.

2. Aggrieved by the respondent's response partly, the appellant filed this first appeal dated 09.02.2022, to CONFED, Puducherry (respondent society), which was forwarded by the respondent society on 01.03.2022 and received by this office on 02.03.2022 (received by this section on 08.03.2022). The said appeal is preferred on the ground that the reply of the respondent-society furnished for Sl.No.3(c), 8( a), 9(b) and 10 are not found satisfactory.

3. The response of the respondent was called for, vide notice dated 11<sup>th</sup> March 2022. The respondent-society furnished their response vide letter dated 21.03.2022 (Copy Enclosed). On perusal, it is observed that the appellant made a substantial appeal based on the information furnished by the respondent on 13.01.2022. Now, the respondent furnished their revised information in respect of Sl.No.3(c), 8( a), 9(b) and 10 vide their letter dated 21.03.2022 which found to be answering the query raised by the appellant in this appeal. Therefore, the plea of the appellant is found to be redressed and nothing remains unanswered.

4. It is observed that if the said information was furnished to the appellant at the time of his application, the appellant would not be pressed to prefer an appeal. Therefore, the respondent society is **directed to meticulously adhere the provisions of the said Act, in letter and spirit** and furnish the available information to the applicant.

5. In view of the above, as nothing survives in this appeal, this first appeal is disposed of.

6. If aggrieved by this decision, a 2<sup>nd</sup> Appeal may be filed, under Section 19(3) of the Act, within 90 days, with the 2<sup>nd</sup> Appellate Authority, whose address is given below:
