ORDER

(Issued under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005)

The appellant submitted an application dated 29.12.2023, under Section 6 of the Right to Information Act, 2005, (hereafter “the Act”) to the respondent-society and sought for certain information. The appellant has stated that, he has not received the reply even after the lapse of 30 days of his application.

2. Aggrieved by the non response of the respondent-society, the appellant filed this first appeal dated 02.02.2024.

3. The response of the respondent-society was called for, vide notice dated 06.02.2024. The respondent-society now furnished their response vide letter dated 01.03.2024 (**Copy Enclosed**). On perusal, it is observed that, now the respondent-society has furnished the available information which was sought by the appellant vide his application dated 29.12.2023. Thus, the plea of the appellant is found to be met out.

4. It is further noticed that, the respondent-society failed to furnish his reply within the stipulated time limit of 30 days. If the respondent-society furnished his reply to the appellant within the stipulated time limit of 30 days, this first appeal wouldn't be preferred by the appellant.

5. Hence, ***the respondent-society is directed to meticulously adhere the provisions of the said Act, in letter and spirit, and henceforth dispose of the applications under the said Act within the stipulated time limit of 30 days; failing which the respondent will be subjected to legal consequences as per the penal provisions of the said Act.***

6. In view of the above, as nothing survives in this appeal, this first appeal is dismissed.

7. If aggrieved by this decision, a 2nd Appeal may be filed, under Section 19(3) of the Act, within 90 days, with the 2nd Appellate Authority, whose address is given below:
