ORDER

(Issued under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act,2005)

The appellant submitted an application dated 19.11.2024, under Section 6 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereafter “the Act”) to the respondent-mill and sought for certain information. The respondent-mill furnished reply to the applicant vide letter dated 13.01.2025.

2. Aggrieved by the response of the respondent –mill for sl.nos.3 & 4 of his Form-1 dated 19.11.2024, the appellant filed this first appeal dated 30.01.2025 (received in this office on 04.02.2025) seeking for information for sl.nos.3 & 4 of his Form -1 dated 19.11.2024.

3. The response of the respondent-mill were called for, vide notice dated 07.02.2025. The respondent-mill furnished its response vide letter dated 08.03.2025 (**Copy Enclosed**). On perusal, the respondent-mill has reiterated its reply already furnished to the appellant on 13.01.2025 for sl.nos. 3 & 4 of his Form-1 dated 19.11.2024 and the following are observed:

a] For Sl.No.3 of the Form-1, the petitioner has requested for a copy of the Subsidiary Conditions governing the service conditions of the employees of the society duly approved by the Registrar of co-operative Societies, for which the respondent-mill has responded that, the petitioner can obtain the subsidiary regulation in their office with payment during office hours. The response of the respondent-mill is not found legally valid. This response shall have been made within 30 days from the date of receipt of the RTI Application. Now, after a time span of 119 days passed away, the response of the mill is found to be inappropriate. Therefore the respondent-mill is ordered to furnish a copy of Subsidiary Conditions governing the service conditions of the employees of the society duly approved by the Registrar of co-operative Societies within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of this order, free of cost.

b] For Sl.No.4 of the Form-1, the petitioner has requested the respondent-mill to specify the relevant Law, Subsidiary Regulations and the Specific Clause under which the retirement on superannuation on attaining 58 years of age are being regulated by the management of the mill, for which the respondent-mill has furnished the available information and the information sought has been found to be met out.

4. In view of the above, this first appeal is disposed of.
5. If aggrieved by this decision, a 2nd Appeal may be filed, under Section 19(3) of the Act, within 90 days, with the 2nd Appellate Authority, whose address is given below:
