ORDER

(Issued under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005)

The appellant submitted an application dated 9.12.2025, under Section 6 of the Right to Information Act, 2005, (hereafter “the Act”) to the respondent-society and sought for certain information. The Respondent-society has not furnished reply to the appellant.

2. Aggrieved by the non-response of the respondent-society, the appellant filed this first appeal dated 19.01.2026 (received on 20.01.2026).

3. The response of the respondent-society was called for, vide notice dated 23.01.2026. The respondent-society has furnished its response vide letter dated 27.01.2026 (**Copy Enclosed**). On perusal, it is observed that, the respondent society has now furnished available information to the appellant which is found to be appropriate and adequate.

4. In view of the above submissions, it is found that, the plea of the appellant is redressed. As nothing survives in this appeal, this first appeal is dismissed.

5. It is further noticed that, the 2nd respondent-society failed to furnish his reply within the stipulated time limit of 30 days. If the respondent-society furnished his reply to the appellant within the stipulated time limit of 30 days, this first appeal wouldn't be preferred by the appellant.

6. ***Hence, the respondent-society is directed to meticulously adhere the provisions of the said Act, in letter and spirit, and henceforth dispose of the applications under the said Act within the stipulated time limit of 30 days; failing which the respondent will be subjected to legal consequences as per the penal provisions of the said Act.***

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7. If aggrieved by this decision, a 2nd Appeal may be filed, under Section 19(3) of the Act, within 90 days, with the 2nd Appellate Authority, whose address is given below:
