**ORDER**

(Issued under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005)

The appellant submitted an application dated 19.01.2026, under Section 6 of the Right to Information Act, 2005, (**hereafter “the Act”**) to the respondent and sought for information pertaining to the Health Employees Co-operative Credit Society Ltd., P.No.475. The respondent furnished response to the appellant vide letter dated 17.02.2026.

2. Not satisfied with the response of the respondent for Sl.Nos.1,3,4,8,9 & 10 of his Form-I dated 19.01.2026, the appellant filed this first appeal dated 09.03.2026 (received in this office on 11.03.2026) on the ground that, the reply received was incomplete and unsatisfactory.

3. The parties are called up for a personal hearing on 02.04.2026. Both the parties are present. During the hearing, the respondent stated that the information related to 20 years only can be furnished as per Section 8(3) of the Act for Sl.No.1of Form-1 dated 19.01.2026 of the appellant. But the appellant did not agree with the said provision and he also did not furnish any supporting documents for his claim. As such, the First Appellate Authority ordered that, the information furnished by the Public Information Officer / Respondent for Sl.No.1 of the appellant's Form-1, dt. 19.01.2026 is legally valid as per the provisions of the Act. Further the First Appellate Authority directed the Public Information Officer / Respondent to furnish the information for Sl. Nos.3,4,8,9 & 10 directly to the appellant under copy to this office, at free of cost within 15 days from the date of receipt of this order.

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4. With the above directions, this appeal is disposed of.
5. If aggrieved by this decision, a 2<sup>nd</sup> Appeal may be filed, under Section 19(3) of the Act, within 90 days, with the 2nd Appellate Authority, whose address is given below:
