ORDER

(Issued under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005)

The protracted desire of the appellant to obtain information from the Puducherry Pudumai Handicrafts Artisans Co-operative Society Ltd., No. P. 652 has resulted in one more first appeal filed under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005. It transpires from his application dated 12.7.2017 that the information directed to be furnished by the society to him vide order dated 17.1.2017 in FA/41/2016 was not furnished. Further, he sought new queries in this application. As this application was not responded, the first appeal came to be filed.

2. Taking the appeal on file, the respondent was directed to file his response. In his response, a copy of which is forwarded to the appellant, the respondent stated that the records of the society are now reconstructed and

the appellant can approach the office to collect copies of the records. The other information requested was furnished in this response.

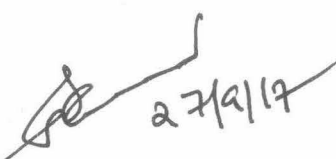
3. The respondent was already directed to provide the information as per order dated 17.1.2017 in FA/41/2016. Admittedly, the records are now reconstructed and in that case the respondent need not expect the appellant to collect the copies of the records from the society and he is duty bound to provide the copies as per the order in the first appeal. The respondent is directed to provide copies of the documents to the appellant within a week from the date of receipt of this order. The respondent is further directed to deal the applications received under the Act with all seriousness and dispose the applications in time and in strict accordance with the provisions of the Act. Any delay or default shall be avoided.

4. With the above direction, the first appeal stands disposed.

5. A second appeal against the decision shall lie with the Central Information Commission, Room No. 305, 2 nd Floor, B wing, August Kranthi Bhavan, Bhikaji Cama Place, New Delhi - 110 066, within ninety (90) days, as provided under Section 19(3) of the Act.
