ORDER:

In the Co-operative Department for an efficient Cooperative organisation to display its vowed goal to serve the public at large, the need of the professional managers with all round ability and aggressive approach was felt necessary. Therefore, the officers in the cadre of Deputy Registrars, Cooperative Officers, Senior Inspectors and Junior Inspectors were deputed to various Cooperative Institutions on foreign service terms. A number of officials working in such foreign service terms is large compared to the strength of the Departments in respect of the above posts. This has, therefore created some problems in their regularisation/confirmation. The details of number of posts sanctioned and number of officers working in the Department and in various Cooperative Institutions are as follows:

2. Due to non-availability of sanctioned posts, the large number of officers as shown above are working on ad-hoc basis, even though they have put in number of years of service and due to

this ad-hoc position much difficulties, and experienced in considering them for promotion to the higher post. This serious situation was under the serious consideration of the Government for some time past.

3. To solve these difficulties, it was decided to create deputation reserve post in the above four (4) cadres without monetary provisions for adjustment of lien, restricting the number to 60% of the total number of officers working on foreign service terms presently.

4. Accordingly, the approval of the Lieutenant Governor has been obtained for the creation of 37 deputation reserve posts at the rate of 60% of the total number of officers working on foreign service term presently as detailed below:
