

ABSTRACT

(S/Co-op) - Filling up of the posts of Deputy Registrar/ Co-operative Officer/ Senior Inspector/Junior Inspector on regular basis - Prescription of percentage of deputation reserved posts in the sanctioned cadre strength Revised - Orders - Issued.

The proposal relates to filling up of vacancies in the grade of Deputy Registrar, Co-operative Officer, Senior Inspector and Junior Inspector on regular basis in the Co-operative Department. For encouraging co-operative movement in public interest, a good number of officers were deputed to various Co-operative Institutions on Foreign Service terms. A number of officials working in such foreign service terms is large compared to the strength of the departments in respect of the above posts. This has, therefore created some problems in their regularization/confirmation. The details of number of posts sanctioned and number of officers working in the Department and in various Co-operative Institutions are as follows:

Due to non-availability of sanctioned posts, the large number of officers as shown above are working on ad-hoc basis even though they have put in number of years of service and due to this ad-hoc position much difficulties, are experienced, in considering them for promotion to the higher post. This obvious situation was under the active consideration of the Government for some time past.

3. To solve the above difficulties, it was decided to create deputation reserve posts in the above four (4) cadres without monetary provisions for adjustment of lien, restricting the number to 60% of the total number Officers working on foreign service terms presently.

4. Accordingly, the approval of the Lieutenant Governor had been obtained and orders were issued for the creation of 37 deputation reserve posts at the rate of 60% of the total number of officers working on foreign service term presently vide G.O. cited as detailed below:

While filling up of vacancies on regular basis and finalisation of post based roster, some administrative difficulties arise on the percentage of deputation reserve posts in the sanctioned cadre strength. To overcome the difficulty, it is now proposed that 20% of the sanctioned cadre strength may be treated as deputation reserve posts as per orders in force. Accordingly approval of the Lt. Governor is hereby accorded for the restriction in the number of deputation reserve post at the rate of 20% of the sanctioned cadre strength as detailed below:
