ORDER

(Issued under Section 141 of the Puducherry Cooperative Societies Act, 1972 read with Rule 104 of the Puducherry Cooperative Societies Rules, 1973)

The Revision-Petitioner was an employee of the Koonichempet Cooperative Milk Producers Society Ltd., No.P.272 (*for short "the society"*). In two criminal cases (C.C. Nos.110 and 111 of 2004) before the Court of Chief Judicial Magistrate at Puducherry, he was found guilty by order dated **17.05.2017**, and hence, sentenced to undergo imprisonment till raising of the Court and to pay fine. Subsequently, on **06.07.2017**, the then Administrator of the society issued a show-cause notice to the Revision-Petitioner, for which, the Revision-Petitioner submitted his reply dated **19.07.2017**. The then Administrator of the society, by the impugned order dated **19.08.2017**, dismissed the Revision-Petitioner from the services of the society.

2) Aggrieved by the impugned order, the Revision-Petitioner filed this revision-petition dated **13.04.2018** under **Section 141** of the Puducherry Cooperative Societies Act, 1972. An application under the said Section 141 shall be preferred within three months from the date on which the proceedings, decision or order to which the application relates, was communicated to the applicant. Admittedly, the



impugned order was made on **19.08.2017**, and hence, this revision-petition should have been preferred before **18.11.2017**. The Revision-Petitioner prayed to condone the delay in preferring this revision-petition, which was resulted due to his health condition and continuous medical treatment, whereas, the said Section 141 doesn't empower the Revisional Authority to condone delay in filing of a revision petition after the expiry of three months.

3) In view of the above, the prayer of the Revision-Petitioner for condonation of delay is disallowed, and consequently, the revision-petition stands rejected on the ground of limitation since it was not filed within the stipulated time limit of three months.
